Improving student mental health: adaptive implementation of school-based cognitive behavioral therapy (PI: Amy Kilbourne)


Funded by the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH), this study will examine the effectiveness of different implementation strategies to improve access to evidence-based mental health care for students with depression and anxiety throughout the state of Michigan. A randomized controlled trial will engage more than 200 school professionals across the state and will compare the effectiveness of three different established strategies to determine the best method to implement the use of cognitive behavioral therapy by school professionals.



The Veterans Affairs cardiac risk score: recalibrating the atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease score for applied use



“Local electronic health record data can be used to estimate CVD better than an established risk score based on research populations. Recalibration improved estimates dramatically, and the type of recalibration was important. Such tools can also easily be integrated into health system’s electronic health record and can be more readily updated.”
